Best Brace in Show was won by the lovely Bowerhinton Elkhounds, mother & son, so similar in type, who moved soundly and beautifully together.

1. Gaved's Tanlap Tinizan. Well made black bitch with dark eye, good bone, tailset and layback of shoulder. Rather at the betwixt and between stage in coat colour at the moment but the promise is all there. She gained in confidence, moving better and better, as the day went on. BP

OPEN BITCH (1e, 0ab)

1. Walker's Ch. Ragoosa Just Jolly at Oraysha JW. Most attractively marked brindle, well named as she obviously loved every moment with constantly wagging, well set and carried tail, so enthusiastic and holds herself with the greatest of pride. Hard to believe she is 13 years old – she could have easily been mistaken for 13 months. Lovely head with dark expressive eyes and big wide nostrils. Just not quite the shoulder of her kennelmate but this one had the better body. Excellent mover, in the best of coat and condition. BV & BVIS

1. Cooper & Dickie's Jonarye Classic Jazz. B/w parti, just six months and full of fun with a charming expression in his dark eyes, good bone and topline. He scored on shoulder and size. Sound and energetic on the move with coat coming on well. Lots of promise here. BP & PG2

PUPPY BITCH (1e, 0ab)

1. Cooper's Forepaws Shes Got the Look. Gold with black mask at her first show and did not care for the echoing hall. Good dark pigment and eye, excellent mouth, in good coat for her age. She moved well but, despite sympathetic handling, did not use her tail. Just needed that little extra confidence that comes with experience and,

indeed, she went better as the day went on to the point that she used her tail perfectly well when competing in the brace class with her father.

Well made all through with excellent shoulder and hindleg, dark eye and pigment with good finish to foreface, level topline and well set tail, in good coat and supremely fit. He moved well. BOB & G3
